WEST BLETCHLEY CARNIVAL SUMMER 2008

The West Bletchley Carnival was historically an annual event organised by the local council. Having considerably outgrown the provisions under the usual Temporary Event Notice in 2008, the council decided to apply for a premises licence for the local park to become the carnival event site with fairground, concessions and main arena entertainment.

The event is the biggest free event in Milton Keynes, so the licence application attracted a great deal of local interest. And for the first time the responsible authorities scrutinized the planning for the event at Safety Advisory Group Meetings. AD Health & Safety helped guide the Council Events team through this process ensuring that fair and achievable conditions were attached to the new licence.

AD Health & Safety also produced all documentation for the actual event, ensured all contractors were working safely and were properly insured and managed safety for the build phase and event phase for both the event sites.
